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Statement of Activities for 2017/18

A Parish Council is required to provide Council tax payers with details of its budget. The 2017/18 information for Newton Parish Council is as follows:

The budget expenditure for 2017/18 is £41,800

This is funded by the parish precept of £13,852 and budgeted income of £11,500 and use of Reserves of £16,448.

The use of Reserves is contingent on the completion of the plan to create a community village hall facility

The increase in total precept of £13,852 for 2017/18 arises from a reduction of the tax base from 300 to 298.8 and an increase of £5.00 on the Band D charge equating to £46.36 per annum

Free reserves are:

Actual at 31 March 2016	£29,206
Estimated at 31 March 2017	£28,831
Estimated at 31 March 2018	£ 6,400

The Council owns, manages and maintains the following facilities in the Parish:

Recreation Area – Play equipment in Wellington Avenue

One telephone kiosks

One community defibrillator is expected to be installed at a location in Wellington Avenue

The Council accepts responsibility for the maintenance of the following Amenities:

Grass at the Wellington Avenue Play area

During the year, the Parish Council plans to establish a fully equipped Play Area and Community Meeting Room facilities.
