ROAD RE-SURFACING UPDATE:

Further to our November 2019 communication regarding the re-surfacing of Wellington Avenue in Newton, councillors have now received additional information from the appointed contractor, Via East Midlands, and are able to report the following update ahead of the proposed works in early February.

Road Re-Surfacing Works - Wellington Avenue & Fairway Crescent

Following requests that Fairway Crescent also be included, the contractor has transferred crews from other jobs in order to expand the scope of re-surfacing works in Newton and hence these will take place over a slightly longer period than originally anticipated. Details provided by Via East Midlands are as follows:

Road Name / Location:	Wellington Avenue (for its entire length) & Fairway Crescent for its entire length (including side roads)
Dates / Times:	From 08.00hrs on Monday 3 rd February until 08.00hrs on Monday 10 th February 2020
Carried Out By:	Via East Midlands on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council
Nature of Restrictions:	 Temporary prohibition of driving, waiting, loading & unloading Wellington Avenue will be closed at night Fairway Crescent will be closed during the day (due to the proximity of homes that front directly onto the road)
Nature of Works:	Carriageway resurfacing works
Alternative Route(s) where applicable:	 These will be signposted on site Resident access will be maintained throughout, although some minor delays may be experienced whilst equipment is moved or key tasks are completed Traffic Marshalls will be on hand throughout to guide residents & maintain bus services (with buses able to turn round at the end of Fairway Crescent)

We understand that letters will be sent to impacted residents ahead of the works so please contact Via East Midlands using the contact details for enquiries above if you need further clarification.

Councillors appreciate that there will be some disruption during the works but are assured that access will be maintained. We trust that Newton residents and other road users will remain patient during the works with the end result of a long-awaited, newly re-surfaced road firmly in sight.
