

Inconsiderate and Dangerous Parking

It has been brought to the attention of the Parish Council, that commercial vehicles, vans and cars are been parked inconsiderately on pavements and dangerously near to corners or junctions.

Residents and councillors are concerned as there have been some 'near misses' and it is causing a serious risk to children and parents having to walk in the road to pass vehicles parked on the pavement.

The Highway Code - Rule 240 - You Should Not Park

On the pavement as it can obstruct and seriously inconvenience pedestrians, people in wheelchairs or with visual impairments and people with prams or pushchairs.

The Highway Code - Rule 244 - You Should Not Park

Opposite or within 10 metres of a junction or bend.

The roads and access ways serving the Bellway / Wilson Homes are subject to a restrictive parking covenant that does not permit certain classes of vehicles to park in / on these areas.

We ask all residents to comply with the Highway Code, and Covenants that may apply, so that no further action is necessary.
